714 North M St

The oldest house still standing in the North Slope was built in 1881 at 714 North M Street. John Geehan, a car inspector for the N.P. Railroad was the original owner whose family lived there at least 45 years. In 1883 a house was built at 802 N L St and in 1885 a house at 718 North M. Two houses built in 1888 are at 1201 North 11th and 419 North J. The five buildings may not look original, as modifications may have been made over the last century.
