It's Time for a PARADE!!!

Children of all ages are invited to participate in the North Slope's Second Annual **Fourth of July Kiddie Parade** beginning at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, July 4. Participants should plan to gather at the corner of N. 12th and N. J streets, near Saint Patrick's Catholic Church.



Once everyone has assembled, we will call upon parents and spectators to help carefully move our spirited parade participants down J Street to N. 8th. At 8th, we'll turn right and travel one more block to the North Slope Park, where lemonade will be served.

All modes of non-motorized transportation are allowed: You can walk, jump rope, bike/trike, rollerblade, skateboard ... younger residents may want to catch a ride in a stroller or wagon. If you play an instrument: Bring it! Decorations are strongly encouraged, as is patriotic apparel. Well-behaved pets on leashes are also welcome.

Think you're too old to march? Impossible! But we also need lots of spectators to line the route and cheer on our little marchers.

Call Before You Hammer

Exterior changes to your house or garage, other than painting and minor repair, must be reviewed by the Tacoma Landmarks Commission. This includes:

- changing or replacing windows.
- changing siding.
- adding, replacing or changing a porch or deck.

Before starting any exterior work, contact Reuben McKnight, our city Historic Preservation Officer (591-5220) or email (Reuben.McKnight@ci.tacoma.wa.us). He can tell you if your project needs a design review and how to proceed if it does.

Auto Row Tour

"Autowalk," a walking tour celebrating Tacoma's historic auto row, is scheduled for Thursday, July 19, from 5 to 8 p.m., beginning at S. 9th and Broadway.



The event, free and open to the public, will spotlight the architecture and the dealerships that

brought Tacoma into the automotive age. The route will extend from S. 9th St. along Broadway to S. 7th Street and north on St. Helens Avenue to South 2nd Street. Information booths, route maps, exhibits, and classic cars on display are planned.

The event is co-sponsored by Historic Tacoma and the Tacoma Historical Society with participation by members of the PSC Buick Club, other local car clubs, and the LeMay Museum.

Autowalk is an effort to raise awareness of Tacoma's automotive and architectural heritage by engaging residents and exploring this portion of downtown. At the end of the walking tour, participants are invited to join in a no-host gathering at St. Helens Café for conversation about historic preservation, automotive history, and economic development.

Meet the Candidates

Voters will head to the polls August 21 for the 2007 Primary Elections. Four City Council seats, two Tacoma Metro Parks Commissioner slots and two Tacoma School District Board seats are among the positions up for grabs in the election.

L Street Lights

The North Slope Historic District Board has lodged a complaint with the City's Public Works Department regarding the recent installation of contemporary streetlights along North I Street. The lights were installed without review by the city's Landmarks Preservation Commission and without notification to affected North I property owners about possible alternatives.

The board has asked that the lights be replaced with historically appropriate ones. Further, the board asked for a meeting with Public Works leadership to ensure that future city decisions coincide with our district's design review process.
